Maintenance

Muddy footprints or a spill, sometimes life happens and your floor gets the marks to prove it. But don't panic, with our spot cleaner you can usually fix it.

1. Spray the spot cleaner directly on the stain and leave to soak for up to a maximum of 5 minutes.
2. Rub firmly with a clean cloth* to remove the stain. For floors with deep structures, use a soft brush.
*We advise to use a white cotton cloth.
3. Repeat the process if necessary.
4. After use, always clean the treated area with clean water.
